



COLLABRE 2022- NATIONAL SEMINAR ON SOCIAL WORK IN DIGITAL WORLD










The event encompassed a range of activities designed to engage students across different interests. The Treasure Hunt challenged participants' problem-





and dignity among the beneficiaries. Such initiatives are instrumental in building an inclusive society where every individual is valued and supported irrespective of their abilities.




