
Report

Christmas Celebration at Ashakiran

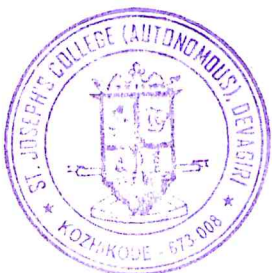

Visit To Adopted Village In Pulpally, Wayanad

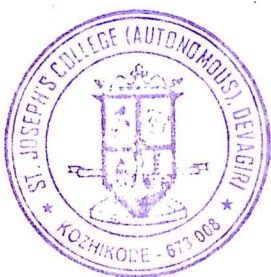

IPM Volunteership

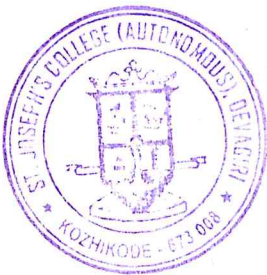
