
All the students in NSS took part in this venture which helped and inculcated in their mind an attitude to preserve their own environment from issues of global warming, scarcity of water etc.



Mosquitoes are really dangerous as it results in spreading several diseases like: Dengue fever, Malaria, etc. So to keep the places clean and tidy is the most important precaution that can be taken to prevent mosquito hunting. Therefore Devagiri College decided to organize an awareness campaign among the school students as it is the best method to spread the message to each household.

The NCC Army Wing organized a campaign on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and the students of Devagiri CMI Public School (plus two) and Savio Higher Secondary School were selected. A talk on the need and methods of eliminating mosquitoes were explained by the Army Wing of Devagiri. The students were asked to spread this message in their locality.
